

CDSS Attending and Preparing for Court

TOP TAKE AWAYS:

- **Caregivers have the right to attend court and be heard**
 - Key Citations: WIC Section 16010.4(b); U.S.C. Section 675(5)(G)
- **15 days before a hearing:** Caregivers have the right to notice of when and where hearings will take place (even virtually)
- **10 days before a hearing:** Caregivers have the right to a written summary of the social worker's recommendations
- **Caregivers can use the Caregiver Information Form, JV-290, to share information with the Judge**
 - The form is available at <https://selfhelp.courts.ca.gov/jcc-form/JV-290>
 - This is an opportunity to share FACTS about how the child in your care
 - Make 8 copies AND keep the original (or submit e-file if available)
 - Yes it's ok to include family photos or letters from providers
